

Painting Indiana 3 – Plein Air Painting in Indiana

Rules for Submission

1. Participating Artists must:
 - i. Be a IPAPA Member (dues paying member 2010 & 2011)
 - ii. Subscribe to the e-mail group at [www. paintingindiana.com](http://www.paintingindiana.com)

1. No limit on number of paintings submitted. No more than ten per artist will be accepted. All paintings MUST be:
 - a. Composed of oil, water color, acrylic, pastel or gouache
 - b. No larger than 24" x 30"
 - c. Fresh – Must NOT have been exhibited in any show, gallery, or internet website.
 - d. 90% Plein Air
 - e. Unsold
 - f. Dry - No Wet Paintings accepted
 - g. Painted between March 2010 – October 2011
 - h. Priced

2. Each submission must be accompanied by the following:
 - a. High quality on-site photo (provide photo in digital and printed format) of painting and scene (artist in photograph, is optional but preferred). This provides proof of the painting being done plein air and may be used in the book.
 - b. Approximately 50 words about what inspired artist to paint subject and its historic significance.
 - c. Completed application (available on line at www.paintingindiana.com)
 - d. \$10 fee

Timeline

1. Artist may paint March 2010 – October 2011
2. Submissions must be made November 12, 2011
3. Notification and accepted paintings will be photographed and all paintings will be returned
4. Text and photos to IU Press by March 1, 2012
5. Book publication and Gala opening – Fall of 2013. Artists will be responsible for framing paintings and delivery

Judging

1. 80 to 100 paintings will be accepted for inclusion in the book
2. There will be one independent judge

Sale of Paintings

1. Artwork will be sold at the opening Gala and traveling venues
2. Artists will receive 50% of the proceeds
3. Artists will be responsible for framing and delivering accepted paintings
